	who survived told me," Al-Sulami said.
	Al-Sulami's two surviving daughters, Manal and Thuraya, were able to swim in the floodwater and hold onto the ceiling fans.
	"When it started to rain heavily, I returned to my house, but it was half
	submerged. I saw it from across the street," he said. "It was quiet except for
	the roaring flood and screams of my daughters Manal and Thuray a."
	Nobody could get close to the two children and they eventually became too
	exhausted to scream. Suddenly there was silence. Al-Sulami thought they
	were gone, lost in the flood.
